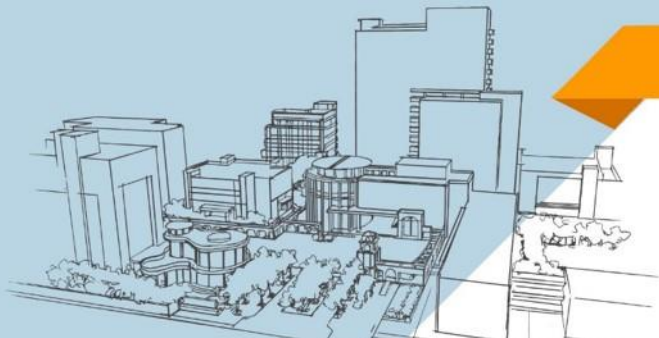

Vacancies due to any students dropping the courses will be filled with other students who register for the course in the order of precedence.

1. In the event of schedule conflicts, the course scheduled afterward for filling the vacancy will replace the original one.
2. Students whose credit number has reached the maximum for the semester will not be considered for filling the course vacancies.
3. If you don't wish to fill the vacancies, click "Give up" .
4. After all students on the waiting list have successfully registered for their intended courses, other students can add such courses through the system.
